School dinners and arrears

School dinners, including the sandwich bar, are free for all children in reception, year 1 and year 2 as part of the Government initiative 'Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM)' which is aimed at improving academic attainment for infant children and to help families save money. Children in Key Stage 2 (from year 3 onwards) are required to pay £2.10 per meal. Order forms for the sandwich bar can be found in the main reception.

It is appreciated that there will be times when payment may be overlooked inadvertently or that an 'emergency' meal may be required on a one off occasion, however at most we will support only 3 outstanding meal payments of £6.30 per child. We ask that payment for meals is made in advance. Thank you.
