If you do not have access to a computer you will be able to use the local library computer facilities. Please contact mytelfordenquiries@telford.gov.uk if you experience any problems with the process.


The closing date for secondary school applications is **31 October 2017**.

Assemblies with Governors Rev Lee Plummer and Mr Raj Mehta

Headlice

We have had reports of headlice. Please check your child's hair regularly and treat if needed. The best way of getting rid of headlice is to carry out the wet combing method, which can take 2 – 3 weeks to clear the hair totally. This is what to do:-

Wash the hair as usual with ordinary shampoo and apply conditioner to the hair. Comb the hair with a wide toothed comb to remove any tangles. Using a **metal** nit comb, gently comb the hair, a small section at a time. The comb will kill or damage most of the big adult lice who are the ones that lay eggs. Rinse hair well. Repeat this process every other day.
