This term in class we are learning about...

- Literacy – Narrative writing (stories with flashbacks and spooky stories) and journalistic writing.
- Numeracy – mental and written mathematical skills using the four number operations: + - x and ÷. Year 6 will begin to have a greater focus on preparing for their SATs in May by looking at question styles and past papers and **will sit mock tests in February**
- Science – Living things and their habitats, to include classification.
- RE – What is charity?
- History – Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England, to include resistance by Alfred the Great and Athelstan.
- Geography - The children will continue to study maps in different scales and this work will link in with The John Muir Award
- French – School.
