READING CHALLENGE

In Year 1 we ask that you read with your child for at least ten minutes on a daily basis, and any reading is recorded in your child's reading diary. We check reading diaries every Friday. However, reading diaries must be brought in to school **EVERY DAY**. If there are three or more reading entries recorded, your child will move up a step on our class reading kite. If by half term, they have reached the top of the kite, they will **win a prize!**

Important Reminders

PE lessons will be taught on Tuesday mornings (outside) and Wednesday afternoons (indoors). Please ensure PE kits are worn on these days. Please ensure water bottles are brought into school **DAILY**.

All items of clothing (including PE kits) must be clearly named and labelled to avoid lost property.
