### A Few Reminders

- All items of clothing, including shoes, should be clearly labelled with your child's name.
- All grapes should be cut in half lengthways.
- Children should not have any nuts or nut based chocolate spread at school due to allergies.

- If your child requires an inhaler they must have one in school <u>at all times</u>. These must be labelled and in date.

- Any leave in school time forms must be submitted to school at least 4 weeks before the required dates.





#### **Breakfast and Afterschool Club**

There are still places available on both Breakfast and Afterschool Club. Breakfast Club costs £3 per session and Afterschool Club is £9 for the first child and £6 for any siblings.

The team are excited to announce that they will be starting a film night on the last Friday of every month. Children will get popcorn and a milkshake. The first session will be Friday 27th September.
