This term in class we are learning about...

### Maths

Over the term in Maths, we will be recalling and using multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. Children will also be solving problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division. Children will be learning how to divide a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number with no remainder initially, eventually leading to division with remainders.

### English

In English, we will start with a focus on the fictional book 'Stone Age Boy'. Children will be reminded on the accurate use of punctuation, handwriting and spelling within their writing.

### Guided Reading

For our Spring term our guided reading book is 'The Iron Man'. During guided reading we will be practising how to answer questions using the information from the text.

### Science

In Science we will be focussing on light and shadows.

### History

Our history focus for this term will be The Bronze and Iron Age.

### Art

In Art we will be focusing on growing artists.

### PE

In outdoor PE sessions children will be playing Tennis. Indoor PE this term is Handball.
